# YOUR DOLLARS AT WORK

The Chilton Medical Center Foundation is dedicated to keeping Chilton on the forefront of health care. In partnership with Atlantic Health System and our generous donor community, we're continually investing in projects that strengthen and expand services, modernize facilities, and enhance clinical capabilities while promoting the best possible experience for our patients, families and visitors.

In 2017, funds primarily supported the following endeavors:

## CHILDREN'S CENTER

Last October, Chilton proudly opened its new Children's Center, thanks, in part, to a Major Gift Initiative that raised over \$600,000. The 4,500 square foot facility reflects an innovative approach to pediatric care, combining the hospital's pediatric emergency room and pediatric inpatient unit in one beautiful, family-friendly space. Exemplifying a commitment to clinical excellence, the center provides seamless, around-the-clock access to pediatric specialists and the full resources of Goryeb Children's Hospital at Morristown Medical Center, which is also part of Atlantic Health System. Along with a separate front entrance and private, colorful rooms, the expanded facility also offers a multitude of special touches that foster healing and reduce stress, such as home-like furnishings, a playroom, mobile toy cart, creative arts and music therapy programs, and sleeping accommodations for parents.



## INTENSIVE CARE UNIT RENOVATION

Construction is underway for a new, state-of-the-art Intensive Care Unit (ICU) that will elevate the level of care for critically ill and injured patients, including those requiring advanced cardiac, stroke and/or pulmonary monitoring and individuals recovering from orthopedic trauma or heart surgery. The \$6.3 million renovation, partially funded by the Chilton Medical Center Foundation, is aimed at optimizing patient safety and comfort while improving access to life-saving medical technology and treatment. The unit will feature several key enhancements, including: larger patient rooms (with private bathrooms), upgraded patient monitoring systems and critical care equipment, additional nursing stations, and a family consultation room. Furthermore, Chilton will introduce a critical care telemedicine program that provides the added expertise of highly skilled intensivists who work in partnership with bedside physicians and nurses.



## CANCER CENTER RENOVATION

Chilton recently commenced a major renovation of its Cancer Center, which offers a full continuum of outpatient cancer services in the hospital's Collins Pavilion. The project is entirely funded by the late Sonia Neill, a former Pompton Plains resident, who generously bequeathed \$2.2 million to Chilton Medical Center's cancer program. Facility enhancements will include a newly designed and equipped Infusion Suite for chemotherapy patients, offices for surgical specialists, a satellite pharmacy, and refurbished spaces for the Breast Center and Radiation Oncology. Construction will be completed in 2018.



## LOBBY RENOVATION

In 2017, Chilton completed the renovation of its main lobby to create a more spacious, modern and welcoming environment for patients and visitors. The project transformed the previous space, providing an open floor plan as well as a more private, efficient reception area, upgraded furnishings and décor for the waiting room and gift shop (including new lighting, flooring and wall coverings), and comfortable seating. This endeavor, supported by a \$75,000 grant from Sordoni Construction Co., marked the first major lobby renovation since the hospital was built.

## Gifts of Hope

### *Couple Donates \$20,000 Toward Behavioral Health Programs*

Manny and Rachel Reiser live 35 miles away from Chilton Medical Center. It isn't the closest hospital, nor the largest, but that doesn't matter to this caring, philanthropic couple from Warwick, New York. In their view, finding the right hospital is about finding a trusted team of physicians along with an institution that instills confidence and peace of mind. That's why the Reisers choose Chilton as their family's primary hospital – as well as a recipient of their charitable giving.

Over the years, Manny and Rachel, both cancer survivors, gradually shifted from their longtime network of New York doctors to a primary care physician and specialists affiliated with Chilton. "Invariably, Chilton has played a larger role in our health care," said Manny. "We've relied on these doctors and the Emergency Room for many of our medical needs, and the care has been excellent."

"We're impressed by the impact of this hospital," asserted Rachel. "We also see Chilton's desire to grow and improve ... and want to be part of it."

In 2015, the couple donated its first gift to Chilton, which was soon followed by two \$10,000 grants to fund a community-based behavioral health education series and a suicide prevention initiative at Chilton. Personally and professionally, the Reiser family has witnessed the perils and needless tragedies associated with mental illness, igniting a passion to promote access to behavioral health screenings and intervention.

"This is a critical, pervasive issue for our society," stated Manny. "Our hope is to remove the stigma associated with mental illness and encourage people to seek help. I get chills thinking that our gift could make a difference ... and potentially save a life."

"Manny and I had vastly different upbringings," added Rachel. "He grew up on welfare; I grew up as a Jew in Iran. Through both of these experiences, we understand the goodness and importance of charity and believe strongly in sharing our blessings with others."





# Building Healthier Communities

## *Sordoni Construction Co. Raises \$150,000 for Chilton*

Sordoni Construction Co. (Sordoni) is proud of its humble beginnings. Over the course of a century, what began as a small family business from Forty Fort, Pennsylvania, has evolved into one of the largest, most prestigious construction companies on the East Coast.

But corporate success is just part of the Sordoni story.

Alongside its vast portfolio of schools, hospitals, offices and other projects, this charitably minded organization is also dedicated to building stronger, healthier communities. Since 2014, Sordoni, headquartered in Bedminster, New Jersey, has raised more than \$150,000 for the Chilton Medical Center Foundation.

“Most of the credit goes to our employees, who worked so hard to sell tickets and sponsorships on behalf of a great cause,” adds Sager. “Ultimately, it’s all about giving back to our communities.”



# LEAVING A LEGACY



## Lincoln Park Resident Bequeaths \$50,000 to Chilton Breast Center

The late Margaret M. Freathy will be remembered as a fighter. Although quiet and often reserved, an unyielding tenacity shaped Margaret's life journey, from her passion for education to her courageous 30-year battle with breast cancer. When the Lincoln Park resident passed on September 3, 2015, at age 78, she left behind a rich, far-reaching legacy that reflected this spirited resolve – and more. In fact, if there's one gift that matched Margaret's iron will, it was her heart of gold.

As her final wish, a vast portion of Margaret Freathy's estate was donated to charity. Her Last Will & Testament directed contributions to many deserving entities, including \$50,000 to benefit the Breast Center at Chilton Medical Center.

According to her brother, Frederick Freathy, Margaret was diagnosed with metastatic breast cancer around 1985. "She lost a close friend to

cancer, which may have influenced her reluctance to seek help," he said. "By the time she saw a doctor, the cancer had already spread."

Nevertheless, Margaret did not surrender easily. Thanks to her dedicated team of physicians and health care providers, she successfully controlled her disease for decades. "Margaret was a lovely, independent woman," recalled Chilton medical oncologist Martin Frank, MD. "With proper treatment, I was able to keep her out of the hospital and enjoying a good quality of life for many years."

Along the way, Margaret developed a connection to Chilton's Breast Center, which played a role in her care. "She was a kind, giving person," asserted Frederick. "In her wisdom and planning, she made sure that everyone was taken care of, including her causes and community."

Margaret's \$50,000 bequest will support several vital enhancements to Chilton's Breast Center, including a new procedure suite and advanced technology for breast biopsy, as well as a breast



health program for women at high risk for breast cancer.

"Margaret would have loved to see those improvements, especially the opportunity for early treatment," added Frederick. "If her gift spares other women from going through 30 years of cancer, she'd be happy indeed."

## Women’s Vision for Health Care Council

The Women’s Vision for Health Care Council completed its second year as a fundamental philanthropic group supporting Chilton Medical Center. 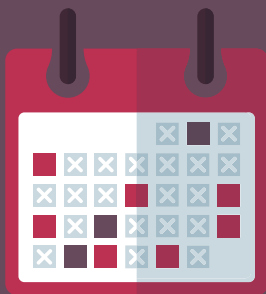
