## **MORRISTOWN MEMORIAL, ROCKAWAY COUPLE FEATURED ON ‘A BABY STORY’**

**MORRISTOWN, NJ, MARCH 12, 2009** — **Rockaway Borough** residents Datnee and Kimani Smith’s heartwarming story of delivering their second child at Morristown Memorial Hospital was featured on The Learning Channel’s national program, “A Baby Story.” The birth of the Smith’s daughter aired at **3 p.m. on Tuesday, March 17.** (Check local listings.)

After the birth of the couple’s first child, Nehemiah, now 5, Datnee Smith conceived but miscarried due to complications from endometriosis. Although they once planned on four children, she and her husband thought they may never conceive again. The sorrow turned to joy when they found out Datnee was expecting. “A Baby Story” producers chronicled the couple’s journey and worked with Morristown Memorial physicians, nurses, and staff to film the birth.

“We had had trouble conceiving, so when we found out we were having another baby, we were so happy and felt so blessed that we wanted a professional to capture the beauty of having this little girl,” Datnee Smith said.

David Garfinkle, MD, of Morristown Memorial, delivered their daughter, Kimberlee Ann Smith, on Friday, Jan. 16, at 5:17pm.

“As soon as I knew I was pregnant, I just knew it was a girl,” Smith said. “We might try for one more but, right now, we are just content. I’m looking forward to watching the show and reliving her birth, but this time with a lot less pain.”
