Transforming Generosity into Exceptional Care

ATLANTIC HEALTH PATIENT & FAMILY CAREGIVERS CENTER— SUPPORTING THE HEARTS BEHIND THE HEALING

In October 2025, the Chilton Medical Center Foundation officially launched a \$1.4 million fundraising campaign to create a dedicated Atlantic Health Patient and Family Caregivers Center—a permanent space designed to provide comfort, dignity and support for those caring for loved ones during some of life's most difficult moments. In just a few short months, the campaign raised an impressive 28% of its goal, reflecting strong early momentum and community support.

Every day at Atlantic Health Chilton, family members and caregivers stand beside loved ones facing illness, injury and uncertainty. They wait through long procedures, absorb complex medical information and provide constant emotional support—often while managing their own fear and exhaustion. Many spend hours sitting in a public, noisy hospital lobby waiting for test results, procedures or critical updates—without privacy, comfort or calm. It's time to change that.



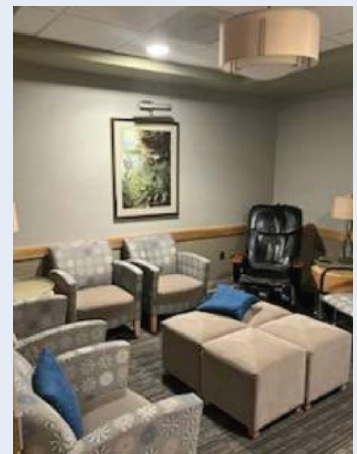
Our Vision: The Atlantic Health Patient and Family Caregivers Center

The Atlantic Health Patient and Family Caregivers Center at Atlantic Health Chilton will transform an underutilized space into a peaceful, welcoming refuge dedicated to caregiver and patient well-being.

Key features will include:

- Private, comfortable seating areas for quiet rest or conversation
- A calming respite environment designed to reduce stress and anxiety
- Educational and wellness resources for caregivers
- Access to trained volunteers or staff for emotional support and hospital navigation
- A patient status and communication board with real-time procedural updates
- Light refreshments and basic amenities for extended stays
- Supportive programming including caregiver groups, mindfulness sessions and stress-reduction tools

Caregivers are the silent heroes in every patient's journey, and they deserve a space offering dignity, peace and support. The foundation looks forward to helping make this meaningful vision a reality.



THE ATLANTIC HEALTH COLLINS PAVILION RENOVATIONS

In 2025, Atlantic Health Chilton held a ribbon cutting to celebrate the grand reopening of the newly renovated, state-of-the-art Atlantic Health Collins Pavilion that houses the oncology and infusion center. The gathering included hospital leaders, physicians, team members, donors and community members.

Atlantic Health Chilton remains committed to leading the way in health care innovation and excellence, and it's a core belief that each cancer patient should have easy access to the highest quality oncology programs and services, from diagnosis to treatment to survivorship.

This project is a significant step forward in fulfilling that promise.

The Chilton Medical Center Foundation raised over \$1.2 million toward the total cost of the project. Key features of the Atlantic Health Collins Pavilion project include:

- **Advanced Treatment Technology Close to Home:** Access to a complete array of oncology outpatient services, including radiation and chemotherapy, immunotherapy and non-cancer-related infusion services just a short distance from home.
- **Patient-Centered Design:** The renovation focused on creating a calming and healing environment, with enhanced privacy in treatment areas and comfortable seating.
- **Comprehensive Care:** Our dedicated, multidisciplinary team of oncologists, nurses and support staff provides personalized care plans tailored to each patient's unique needs.
- **Updated Infusion Area:** The renovated suite now has six additional infusion areas, bringing the total initial patient infusion areas from 12 to 18. This has allowed the center to go from an average of 22 daily patients to 40, while improving comfort, convenience and care for patients undergoing infusion therapy.

The newly renovated Atlantic Health Collins Pavilion is a testament to the generosity of our donors and their commitment to health care in their community—thank you to the many donors and event sponsors who supported this project!



INVESTING IN EXCELLENCE: SCHOLARSHIPS FOR TEAM MEMBERS

In 2025, the Chilton Medical Center Foundation launched its first-ever scholarship program, recognizing the need for continued investment in our clinical teams to ensure the highest quality of patient care. Through this initiative, up to 15 team members are awarded \$2,500 each to support their pursuit of nursing education, whether full- or part-time.

Eligible applicants must have worked at Atlantic Health Chilton for at least one year and be enrolled in—or accepted to—a BSN, MSN, DNP, or PhD program at an accredited four-year college or university, with a minimum GPA of 2.0. The application process opens each spring, providing team members with an opportunity to advance their education and grow their careers.

DONOR SPOTLIGHT

Leslie and Dave Little have been loyal supporters of Atlantic Health Chilton and the Chilton Medical Center Foundation since 1989.

When asked why they first became involved with the foundation, Leslie explained that it was when she was prescribed physical therapy. Leslie wanted to have her physical therapy sessions at Atlantic Health Chilton, but the equipment she needed for her recovery wasn't available there at that time. In that moment, Leslie decided she wanted to do something about that and discussed it with her husband Dave.

"I asked how much the equipment was and we donated the funds to purchase it for Chilton," explained Leslie. "We saw a need, and I wanted to make sure other people had access to this type of equipment so they wouldn't have to travel for something like physical therapy."

Over the years, the Littles have been involved in numerous fundraising campaigns for the Chilton Medical Center Foundation. They attend foundation events and Leslie is a member of Chilton's Women's Vision Council.

Leslie previously worked at the Atlantic Health Chilton Breast Center in the Atlantic Health Collins Pavillion but is now retired. As a result of her work experience, the breast center and women's health remain particularly close to her heart.

Compassion in Action: Patient Journeys Made Possible

KATHY M.

In early August of 2025, Kathy M. underwent long-delayed hip replacement surgery at Atlantic Health Chilton, finally prioritizing her own health after years of caring for her husband at home.

Though initially nervous, Kathy was immediately struck by the hospital's calm, welcoming environment. "I felt like I was in their home—it was all about caring for me," she shared.

From pre-op through recovery, her experience was defined by clear communication, compassion and a deeply personal approach to care. Every member of her team, from nurses and physicians to therapists and support staff, took the time to explain each step, ensuring she felt informed and at ease. One moment stood out in particular: waking gently in a quiet recovery room, guided by a nurse's soft, reassuring voice. "That sense of calm stayed with me the entire time," she said.

Kathy's care team also recognized her concerns about her husband at home, offering patience, understanding and meaningful connection. They encouraged her to stay an additional night to rebuild strength and stability—guidance she now deeply appreciates.

When it was time to return home, Kathy felt fully prepared thanks to thorough discharge instructions and continued support. Today, she is healing well and making strong progress through physical therapy.

Reflecting on her experience, she shared, "I don't usually complete surveys, but I had to for this. The care was extraordinary. If I ever need a hospital again, I know where I'll go."
