Through the generosity of our donors, Chilton Medical Center can continuously expand vital programs and services, enhance clinical education, prioritize excellence in patient care – and so much more.



Why Giving Matters

As a nonprofit hospital, Chilton Medical Center depends on the generosity of our donors to assist in the delivery of medical excellence, provide state-of-the-art technology, and sustain essential programs and services. It's all about connecting people with the care they need, when they need it. Your gift directly changes lives through health, hope and healing.



Some key philanthropic milestones

- **1947** In memory of their son, Forrest S. Chilton III, and other area service men and women who had given their lives in WWII, Forrest S. Chilton II, MD, and his wife Elizabeth donate the land to build Forrest S. Chilton III Memorial Hospital.
- **1948** A \$200,000 capital campaign is launched, paving the way for construction of the hospital to begin in July of 1949.
- **1949** The Chilton Memorial Hospital Auxiliary hosts their first fundraising event.
- **1953** A \$150,000 capital campaign is launched. One year later, the 50-bed Chilton Memorial Hospital is dedicated.
- **1958** A \$400,000 expansion campaign begins, enabling Chilton Memorial Hospital to increase capacity to 111 beds.
- **1965** A \$125,000 capital campaign is launched to fund a four-bed Intensive Care Unit.
- **1974** The first Chilton Memorial Hospital phonathon raises \$17,000.
- **1981** The West Parkway groundbreaking launches the "Meeting New Challenges for You" \$25.5 million capital campaign.
- **1987** Gordon and Bonnie Steinmetz of Kinnelon donate \$200,000 for the construction of an Interfaith Chapel.
- **1991** Doris and Bob Collins of Kinnelon donate more than \$1 million toward construction of the Chilton Cancer Treatment Center at the Collins Pavilion.
- **1993** "Chilton 2000 Campaign for Life," the Foundation's \$4.5 million capital campaign is launched.
- **2005-2007** The "Vision for Tomorrow" Major Gift Initiative begins.
- **2015** The Children's Center at Chilton Medical Center Major Gift Initiative kicks off with a goal of \$500,000.
- **2018-2019** Chilton's Campaign for Emergency Care begins with a goal of \$2.8 million.
- **2021** The Foundation funds Chilton Medical Center's state-of-the-art daVinci robotic surgery system.
- **2023** The Foundation launches their plan to expand Infusion Services at Chilton Medical Center and raises over \$1.3 million.
