FOUNDATION BOARD SPOTLIGHT Daryl Rogers

For the Chilton Medical Center Foundation's newest board member, Daryl Rogers, Chilton Medical Center means family—in more ways than one.

Daryl lives in the area with his wife and six children—all of whom were born at Chilton Medical Center. Daryl joined the Chilton Medical Center Foundation Board nearly

one year ago, following in the footsteps of two family members who served on Chilton's boards for several years.

Adding to the familial connections, Daryl's mother was a nurse in Chilton Medical Center's Maternity Unit, and Daryl recalls hearing about the Chilton Medical Center Foundation often over the years.

"I'd always heard my mom talk about the money that was raised by the Foundation for various hospital projects," he said. "It's nice to see that

Ironically, Daryl also previously worked at Chilton Medical Center and in Atlantic Health System's corporate office.

"I started in 2000 as a transporter in

Chilton's Imaging Department to get my foot in the door. Then I went on to school to become a respiratory therapist and worked at Chilton for about 12 years," said Daryl. "After that, I went on to work in the corporate side of Atlantic Health for 17 years as director of professional services."

"I find it helps in my role as a Foundation Board

member to be familiar with the clinical and business sides of health care." Darvl added.

Currently, Daryl is chief executive officer of Hope Christian Services in Wyckoff-a position he has held since 2020. Hope Christian Services serves individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities through their main campus in Wyckoff and operates 19 group homes in Passaic and Bergen counties. A team of over 300 offers therapy services and day programs to over 100 intellectually and developmentally disabled individuals.

Daryl is enjoying acclimating to the Chilton Medical Center Foundation Board and attending Foundation events. Soon he'll be part of the planning committee for the Chilton Golf Classic to be held in September.

When asked what stands out to him so far during his time with the Chilton Medical Center Foundation Board. Darvl was quick to answer. "I better appreciate the philanthropic work that the Foundation has accomplished. It's great to see from behind the scenes how much has been done to enhance essential programs like cancer services and more."

Would he recommend involvement with Chilton Medical Center and the Foundation to others?

"Absolutely-it's important to get involved with your community and give back," stressed Daryl. "Like my family before me, I'm giving back to Chilton because this hospital has already given so much to us."


