Transforming Generosity into Exceptional Care

ONCOLOGY EXPANSION AT SPARTA HEALTH AND WELLNESS

In 2025, our fundraising efforts centered on a key priority—the Oncology Expansion at Sparta Health and Wellness, a \$6.6 million renovation project aimed at enhancing and expanding cancer care services. Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our donors, more than 95% of the fundraising goal has been achieved, reflecting a strong vote of confidence in this important initiative.

With funding nearly complete, construction on the expanded oncology space is now underway. The redesigned treatment and physician areas are being thoughtfully developed with patient comfort, efficiency and dignity in mind—creating a more modern, welcoming and patient-centered environment for those receiving care. This expansion will further strengthen both the patient experience and the care team’s ability to deliver comprehensive oncology services.

This vital project is already increasing our capacity to serve patients by adding new infusion chairs and establishing an on-site pharmacy, streamlining treatment and improving convenience for those undergoing care. Philanthropic support has also enabled the recruitment of an additional oncology provider to join Dr. Waina Cheng’s practice, expanding access and helping meet the growing demand for services across the region.

As the campaign nears completion, we celebrate the meaningful impact made possible by our donors—ensuring that patients in our community can access high-quality, compassionate oncology care close to home.



NURSING RELAXATION ROOM

The Newton Medical Center Foundation celebrated the opening of a dedicated Nursing Relaxation Room at Atlantic Health Newton, created to support the well-being of its nursing team. This calming space was made possible through a generous gift from John and Pat Kennedy of Blairstown, given in gratitude for the exceptional care they received.



In a fast-paced, high-stress clinical environment, spaces like this play an important role in supporting caregiver wellness, helping to reduce stress, prevent burnout and promote resilience among nursing staff. Designed as a place of respite, the room features massage chairs, soothing music, specialty teas, aromatherapy and a custom feature wall in tranquil shades of blue and green.

Thanks to the Kennedys' thoughtful generosity, nurses now have a welcoming space to recharge, supporting both their well-being and their ability to continue delivering exceptional patient care.



MATERNITY RENOVATIONS



Atlantic Health Newton officially opened its newly renovated maternity unit in 2025 with a ribbon cutting, completing a project designed to improve comfort and care for mothers and babies in Sussex and Warren counties.

The updated unit includes 17 private maternity suites with upgraded features like sleeping couches, quiet workspaces, lounge chairs and storage, making it more comfortable for partners, visitors and families.

Supported by the Newton Medical Center Foundation as part of a broader \$3.5 million investment, the renovation marks a significant milestone in the hospital's ongoing efforts to enhance patient experience and clinical excellence.

The maternity unit renovation marks the final phase of the Newton Medical Center Foundation's "Your Care, Our Future" campaign, which funded three key facility projects, also including the renovation and redesign of the Behavioral Health Patient Unit in the emergency department and a newly designed and enhanced intensive care unit (ICU).

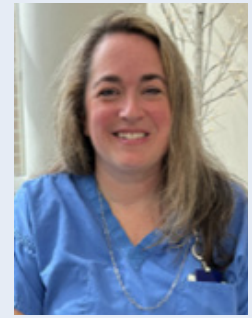
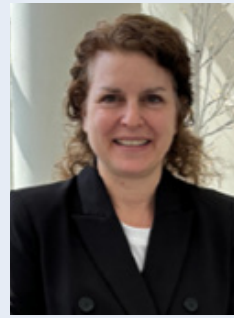

INVESTING IN EXCELLENCE: NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS

ROBOTIC PET THERAPY

The Newton Medical Center Foundation recently funded a mini grant for a Robotic Pet Therapy at Atlantic Health Newton. Robotic Pet Therapy has become an important supportive tool at Newton because it provides emotional comfort, reduces stress, and improves well-being for our patients.

As a result, Cristen Mackwell, clinical nurse specialist for research and innovation, recently presented "The Impact of Robotic Pets in the Emergency Department: A New Frontier in the Patient Experience" at the World Nursing Science Conference held in San Francisco.



MOBILITY AIDE

A new mobility assistance service has been introduced at Atlantic Health Newton, expanding access to care for patients who need transportation support. Through this initiative, trained mobility aides provide safe, non-emergency transport for individuals with limited mobility, including wheelchair-based patients traveling to and from medical appointments.



Mobility aides are specially trained to assist patients with care and dignity, helping them safely enter and exit vehicles, securing them during transport and ensuring a comfortable experience throughout their journey.

This service helps remove a common barrier to care by improving access for vulnerable patients, supporting timely appointments and enhancing overall patient experience across the community. It also complements the broader work of Atlantic Mobile Health, which provides medical transportation services throughout the region.

By investing in mobility support, Atlantic Health Newton continues to strengthen its commitment to patient-centered care—ensuring individuals can access the services they need safely, reliably and with compassion.

Fundraising Events

The generosity of donors in 2025 enabled continued growth of the supportive and compassionate health care environment at Atlantic Health Newton. Gifts—large and small—helped fund new services, advance clinical excellence and ensure that patients and families receive care with dignity, comfort and hope.

Together, we are shaping the future of community health and making lasting impacts every day. Here is a recap of our 2025 signature events.

HEART AND SOUL – A COMMUNITY CELEBRATION

The Newton Medical Center Foundation hosted its annual Heart & Soul – A Community Celebration at Perona Farms, honoring first responders and frontline caregivers from across Sussex and Warren counties.

The event recognized lifesaving efforts in the field and at Atlantic Health Newton and Atlantic Health Hackettstown, and featured powerful stories of AED saves made possible through the foundation's AED Program. More than 200 guests attended, and awards included the Scott Danielson Heart of Saving Lives Award and the Visions Team Award.



Honorees included regional EMS, police, fire and health care teams, as well as Atlantic Health Newton's emergency department and cardiac catheterization lab. The evening concluded with live bidding to fund additional AEDs. Combined with sponsorships, the event raised more than \$57,000 in support of the foundation's AED Annual Fund. Since launching in 2001, the AED Program has placed more than 1,100 AEDs, trained over 7,000 individuals and helped save 83 lives, including five in 2025.

AN EVENING OF WINE AND ROSES

The Newton Medical Center Foundation and the Foundation for Hackettstown Medical Center hosted over 500 attendees, sponsors and volunteers at our 2025 "An Evening of Wine & Roses" at Perona Farms in Andover.

The Grand Prix celebration-themed event featured music, raffles and a tasting of fine wines, spirits and culinary specialties from several of Sussex and Warren counties' top restaurants. A VIP guest option took the experience to an even higher level, with special race-themed delicacies and signature drinks.



Over \$295,000 was raised and all proceeds from this popular annual event remained local to support important projects at Atlantic Health Newton and Atlantic Health Hackettstown.



FRANK REDFERN MEMORIAL GOLF OPEN

With June temperatures climbing into the mid-90s at Lake Mohawk Golf Club, it was a hot day of golf in more ways than one. KAREN R.

After a routine mammogram at Atlantic Health Newton in early 2018, Karen R. was diagnosed with breast cancer—just four years after supporting her late husband through his own cancer journey.

Following successful surgery and radiation at Atlantic Health Morristown Medical Center, she began a four-year course of oral medication requiring ongoing monitoring, including regular oncology visits and imaging.



Wanting to stay closer to home for this next phase of care, Karen chose Atlantic Medical Group's Sparta oncology office. There, she found not only convenience, but a deeply supportive and compassionate environment.

"We have such excellent cancer care right here in our area. If you take the time to do your research, you'll see that you don't have to travel far to find quality oncology services," said Karen.

Under the care of Dr. Waina Cheng, Karen felt at ease from the start. "From my first visit, I felt a sense of comfort and warmth," she shared. "Dr. Cheng took her time with me and truly cared about me as a person, not just as a patient."

Karen also praised the welcoming staff and patient-friendly setting, noting that each visit felt reassuring rather than overwhelming. She appreciated the accessibility of high-quality cancer care in her own community and is encouraged by plans to expand and enhance the Sparta facility.

Karen completed her treatment feeling confident, supported and grateful. Today, she is cancer-free and back to routine monitoring. Reflecting on her experience, she encourages others to seek exceptional oncology care close to home—just as she did.

The Guardian Angel Program at Atlantic Health Newton provides patients, families and community members with a meaningful opportunity to recognize caregivers who have made a lasting impact through exceptional compassion, dedication and service.
