AHS Carelink

Community and non-Epic providers can access records from care provided at AHS facilities live on Epic securely via their web browser using AHS Carelink. AHS Carelink also allows these providers and their practices to:

- Receive admission and discharge alerts.
- View clinical information and clinical history.
- View pre-populated clinic patient lists.
- View their surgeons' schedules.
- Send messages to AHS providers on Epic.

Results Routing

Community providers and providers not on Epic, with a few exceptions, receive results via fax. They can also be viewed and printed from AHS Carelink. Details on results routing are available on the attached grid.

Some cardiology and lab results are routed from systems outside of Epic and may be communicated differently.

Direct Exchange

Community and non-Epic providers with an EMR in their practice may be able to participate in an HIE or other data exchange tools to receive direct messages that integrate patient data right into their own EMR.
