Who	 An AHS Carelink account <u>MUST</u> be requested for all <i>practices</i> that are not using AHS Epic as their practice EMR.
	 Practices of providers who are getting Hyperspace training will need Carelink access for their office staff in order for the staff to access records as they now use Access1MD. The provider themselves do NOT get a Carelink account – they will use Epic Hyperspace.
	 Providers who do not round at the hospitals, and are therefore not getting trained in Epic, and their office staff will all need to obtain Carelink access, as Access1MD will not allow access to records from sites live on Epic.
	 An AHS Carelink account should NOT be requested for: A provider (or any user) who has an Epic Hyperspace account, or is/will soon be signed up to attend Epic training. Anyone who already has a Healthy Planet Link account through the ACO. Anyone using Epic as their practice EMR.
What	AHS Carelink is Epic's web-based application for connecting to community affiliates. AHS Carelink gives non-Epic providers secure access to select patient information stored in the AHS Epic electronic medical record.
