*****To be eligible for the Non-Profit/Not-for-Profit subsidy, a municipality, town, school or other health and safety not-for-profit organization must demonstrate to the NMC Foundation that it normally has contact with a sufficient number of people so as to justify the need for a heart defibrillator; that it has a location and attending personnel that would allow for the defibrillator's immediate use; and that it will contribute \$750.00 towards the purchase of the defibrillator and can arrange training with the NMC Community Education Program.***
