

Lifesaving Care – Close to Home

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), someone has a heart attack every 40 seconds in the United States. Every year, about 805,000 Americans have a heart attack. Of these:

- › 605,000 are a first heart attack
- › 200,000 happen to people who have already had a heart attack
- › About one in five heart attacks is silent — the damage is done, but the person is not aware of it.


In 2020, Newton Medical Center will be advancing its cardiac services to address this critical health care need in our community.

New Percutaneous Coronary Intervention Program for STEMI Patients

Newton Medical Center has been approved by the N.J. Department of Health for a Certificate of Need License to perform percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) on STEMI patients. STEMI patients are those who are having an acute myocardial infarction (heart attack). Typically, these patients can be transported by their local EMS, walk into the Emergency Department, or be an inpatient. This is a cardiac emergency, and rapid treatment is required to avoid further deterioration in cardiac status or death.

Treatment

Patient is taken to the Cardiac Cath Lab for a cardiac catheterization to visualize the coronary arteries to look for narrowed or blocked vessels. If treatment is required, a catheter with a small balloon catheter is inserted, and the vessel is opened, and a stent placed to keep the vessel open.




GE Imaging System

To assist Newton Medical Center in expanding its cardiology services and saving more lives, the Newton Medical Center Foundation is embarking on a \$1.4 million project to fund a new Cardiac Cath Lab imaging system in our Charles L. Tice Heart Center. The current system is over 14 years old and is at its end of life.

This new imaging system offers a comprehensive suite of functionality customized for a wide range of procedures. With the flat-panel digital detector, it offers excellent visualization of the heart and its chambers. The system is designed from the ground up to provide the image clarity needed to support well-informed decisions.

The interventional field is growing with ever-expanding capabilities and migration to less invasive, safer and more cost-efficient procedures. With this new technology and advanced interventional imaging software, clinicians can expand their versatility and successfully plan, guide and assess increasingly sophisticated procedures with greater precision and dose efficiency.
