



Please review the following information before proceeding to the information desk.

To ensure the safety and well-being of our patients, visitors and team members, the following is required of all who enter this Atlantic Health System location:

1. In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and the New Jersey Department of Health, everyone entering this location must wear a face mask at all times while in the building. Those who do not have a mask can obtain one from the visitor station.

2. Visitors are **not permitted** if they have:

- Tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days or have a pending COVID-19 test due to COVID-19 symptoms or exposure
- Have COVID-19 symptoms including:
 - › Fever or chills
 - › Fatigue
 - › Sore throat
 - › Cough
 - › Muscle or body aches
 - › Congestion or runny nose
 - › Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - › Headache
 - › Nausea or vomiting
 - › New loss of taste or smell
 - › Diarrhea

3. Everyone entering this location must use the thermal scanner to confirm they do not have a fever.

4. Visitors should perform hand hygiene using the hand sanitizers located at the entrance and in the patient's room.

5. Those visiting COVID-19 patients **must stop** at the nursing desk on the patient's unit for additional instructions to ensure their safety.
